2. OPENING ACTIVITY

WHAT YOU NEED: "True or False Cards" Activity Pages, "True or False Leader Guide" Activity Page, and a timer

WHAT YOU DO:

- · Divide the kids into two teams.
- If you have a wide range of ages, balance older and younger kids on each team.
- Instruct each team to sit together.
- Give each team a set of cards from the "True or False Cards" Activity Page.
- Explain that you will share a statement about Christmas from the "True or False Leader Guide" Activity Page.
- Instruct each team that they have 10 seconds to work together to decide if they think the statement is true or false.
 - Correct answers will score one point for the team.
 - The team with the most points at the end wins.
- Read one statement from the "True or False Leader Guide" Activity Page and set the timer for 10 seconds.
- Direct each team to hold up their "True" or "False" answer card when the timer sounds.
- Announce the correct answer.
 - For fun, invite kids to share why statements are false—see the "True or False Leader Guide" Activity Page.
- Repeat for each statement on the "True or False Leader Guide" Activity Page.
- Celebrate the team with the most points as the winner.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Great job, friends! I bet you learned some new things about Jesus' birth and Christmas from that game! Is anyone else wondering why we're talking about Christmas in July? Kind of funny, right? [Transition] Let's go to Large Group to discover what Jesus' birth has to do with what we're learning about this month!"

Lead your group to the Large Group area.

an activity that promotes empathy and facilitates biblical application through role-play and reenactment



1. CANDY CANE CHARADES [TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Bible Story Action Cards" Activity Page, "Bible Story Prompt Cards" Activity Page, and candy canes (or prepared pipe-cleaner candy canes)

TODAY'S BIBLE STORY

BASIC TRUTH

I can trust God no matter what.

WHAT YOU DO:

- Place the stack of cards from the "Bible Story Action Cards" Activity Page at one end of your group space.
- Instruct the kids to sit on the other side of your group space.
- Spread out each of the cards from the "Bible Story Prompt Cards" Activity Page in front of the group where everyone can see them.
- Invite the kids to play a special version of Charades where the goal is to win the shepherd's staff (candy cane).
- Choose the kid who celebrated a birthday most recently to be the first "actor."
- Direct the "actor" to run to the other side of the group space, choose a card from the pile of cards from the "Bible Story Action Cards" Activity Page, and act out the scene without saying any words.
 - For younger kids who are the "actors," point out the word in bold on each card for them to focus on acting out.
- Instruct the rest of the group to try to guess which scene from the Bible Story the "actor" is acting out by referencing the set of cards in front of them from the "Bible Story Prompt Cards" Activity Page.
 - Optional: For a group of mostly older kids, remove the "Bible Story Prompt Cards" Activity Page from play.
- Give the kid in the group who correctly guessed the action a candy cane and direct them to be the next "actor."
- Also award the "actor" a candy cane since their acting resulted in an accurate guess.
- Continue until all of the action cards have been played.
 - If you have more kids than cards, re-use cards until every kid has had a turn.
- Challenge the kids to work together to place the "Bible Story Prompt Cards" Activity Page in order of the story.
- Optional: Ensure every child has a candy cane to take home later.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"That was awesome! You all were such good actors, and look at all the shepherds in this group with their shepherd's hooks! Isn't it amazing how God chose ordinary shepherds to deliver the extraordinary news of Jesus' birth? It reminds me of how simple it can be for any of us to bring joy to everyone we meet.

"What are some ways we can be like the shepherds and spread good news to the people in our lives? (Invite responses. Encourage kids to think of simple acts of kindness, like: writing a card to a loved one, giving someone a compliment, or donating used toys.)

*2. BE GOOD NEWS [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: White copy or construction paper, and green markers; Optional: Christmas stickers and markers

WHAT YOU DO:

- Instruct the kids to sit in a circle.
- Ask: "What do you think it means to be 'good news' to someone?" (Invite responses.)
- Give each kid one piece of paper.
- Set out the markers.
- Instruct the kids to draw the outline of a large Christmas tree, taking up the entire page.
 - For younger kids, show them how to draw a long, skinny triangle for the tree and a small rectangle for the stump.
- Direct the kids to draw one large ornament hanging from their tree in any shape they'd like (a circle, a star, etc.) as long as there is room to draw or write inside the ornament.
- Instruct the kids to draw one or two large squares under their tree to represent gifts that are also large enough to draw or write in.
- Challenge the kids to think of one person in their life who could use a little bit
 of joy this week. (Maybe it's a sick family member or a neighbor who just lost
 their pet. Share an idea first to get the conversation going.)
- Invite any kids who would like to share who they chose and why they thought of them.
- Direct the kids to draw or write the name of their person inside of their ornament.
- Encourage the kids to think of 1-2 things they might do to be "good news" to their person. (They might choose to leave a note of encouragement in their neighbor's mailbox or offer to do their family member's chores this week.)
- Invite any kids who would like to share.
- Instruct the kids to draw or write their ideas inside their drawings of gifts that are underneath the tree.
- If time allows, as an option, allow kids to color in or decorate their Christmas tree drawings with stickers.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Thank you all for sharing such great ideas! I hope you get the chance to be 'good news' to the people you thought about today. When you choose to share good news with the people in your life, you are showing them the love of Jesus.

[Make It Personal] (Share an age-appropriate story about a time in your life when someone was "good news" to you. How did it make you feel? What did it teach you about God's love?)

Optional Discussion Questions for Older Kids

If you lead 4th, 5th, or 6th graders, consider asking these discussion questions:

- Why do you think God chose ordinary shepherds to deliver such an important message?
- In what ways can we share the joy of Jesus with others, like the shepherds did?
- How might encountering Jesus change our lives today?

3. MEMORY VERSE MOTION CHALLENGE [HEAR FROM GOD | MEMORY VERSE ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Bibles

WHAT YOU DO:

• Make sure each kid has a Bible.

Finding verses with a multi-age group: Guide all kids to open their Bibles to the front and find the table of contents. (Hold up a Bible opened to the table of contents to show

the kids what the page looks like.) When the kids find the table of contents, ask a middle

elementary kid (2nd-3rd grade) to find Philippians in the list under "New Testament." When

the kid finds Philippians, lead them to look at the page number beside the word and say it aloud, explaining that the number tells them on what page they can find Philippians. Ask older elementary kids (4th-5th grade) to help younger ones find the correct page in their own Bibles. When they all find Philippians, explain that the big numbers on the page are

the chapter numbers. Ask a kindergartner or 1st grader to find chapter 4, and give time for all the kids to turn the pages to find it. Explain that the small numbers are verse numbers,

and ask a middle elementary kid to find verse 4 in chapter 4. Then, read the verse aloud slowly, especially for your pre-readers, or ask older elementary kids to read it to the group.

Together, look up Philippians 4:4, using the Bible

BASIC TRUTH

- Invite the group to come up with motions for the Memory Verse.
- Kids can share multiple ideas for each part of the verse, then invite the group to agree on one.
- Share the following verse motion ideas, if needed:
 - Always" While pointing up, circle your pointer finger around twice
 - "be joyful" jump in the air, throwing arms out and around
 - "because you" point to a friend
 - "belong" hug yourself
 - "to the Lord." point to the sky
 - "I will say it again." walk around in a circle
 - "Be joyful!" jump in the air, throwing arms out and around
 - "Philippians 4:4, NIrV" palms together and then open them like a book

- "Rejoice" jump in the air, throwing arms out and around
- "in the Lord" point to the sky
- "always." While pointing up, circle your pointer finger around twice
- "I will say it again:" walk around in a circle
- "Rejoice!" jump in the air, throwing arms out and around
- "Philippians 4:4, NIV" palms together and then open them like a book

WHAT YOU SAY:

"That was fun! How many of you think you will be able to show someone in your family your Memory Verse motions today? (Invite responses.) Great! Our verse reminds us that because Jesus brings joy to the world, and we belong to Him, we will ALWAYS have something to be joyful about. Nice job, everyone!" (Give each kid a high five or fist bump.)
