



Lead Teacher

Part-Time 24-32 hr/week (during school year)

The Lead Teacher is responsible for guiding and instructing children through creative planning and implementation of a developmentally appropriate daily program of activities promoting each child's affective, cognitive, physical, perceptual-motor, communicative, social and spiritual competence. They will directly report to the Preschool Director.

Lead Teacher Job Duties:

- Provide a welcoming, inclusive learning atmosphere for all students
 - Support creativity and learning
 - Provide supervision during activities
 - Select age-appropriate developmental materials for the classroom
 - Keep classroom neat and organized
 - Provide parents with progress reports
 - File incident reports as needed
 - Prepare for lessons by gathering materials or setting up activities

Lead Teacher Prerequisites:
