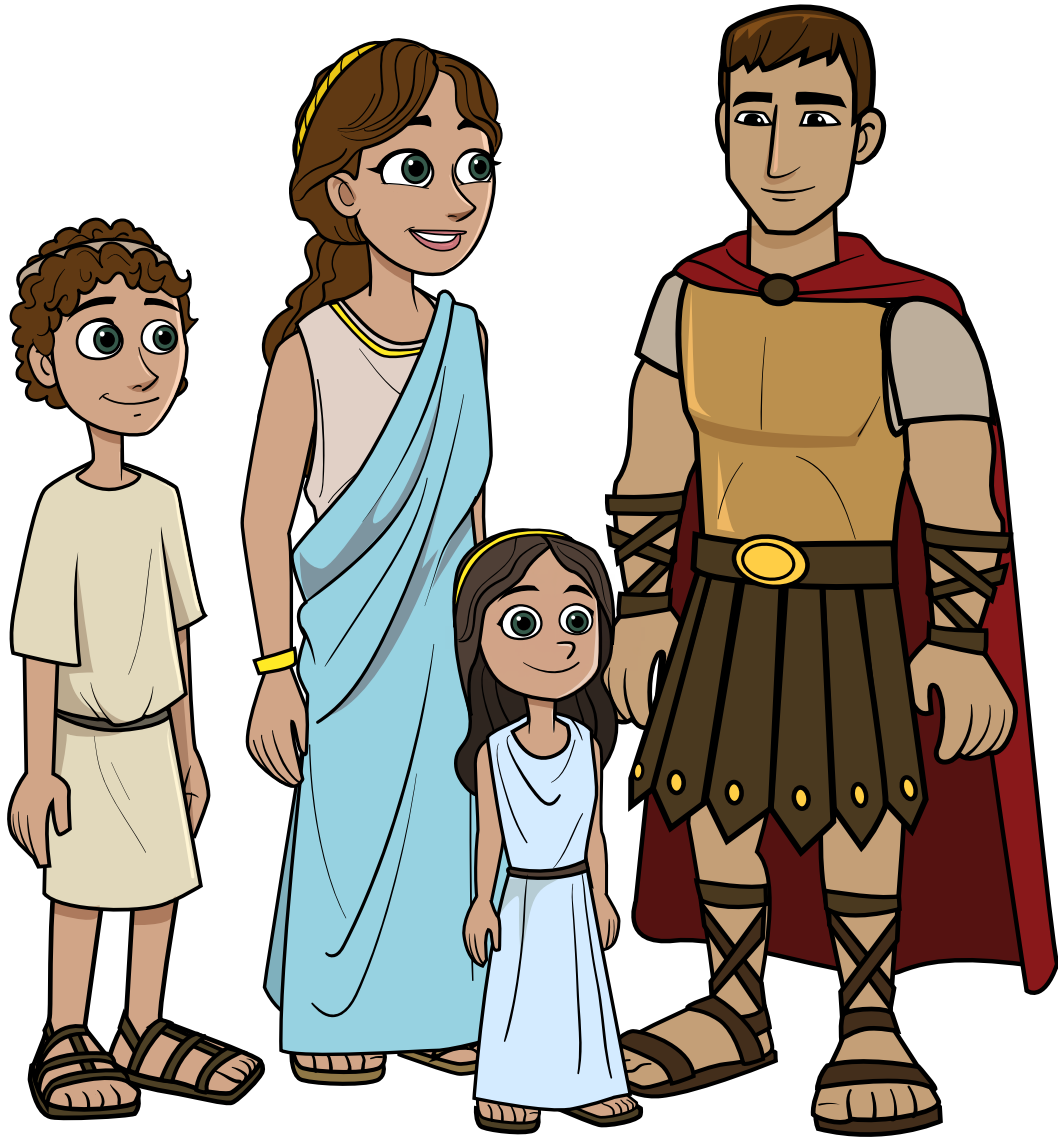
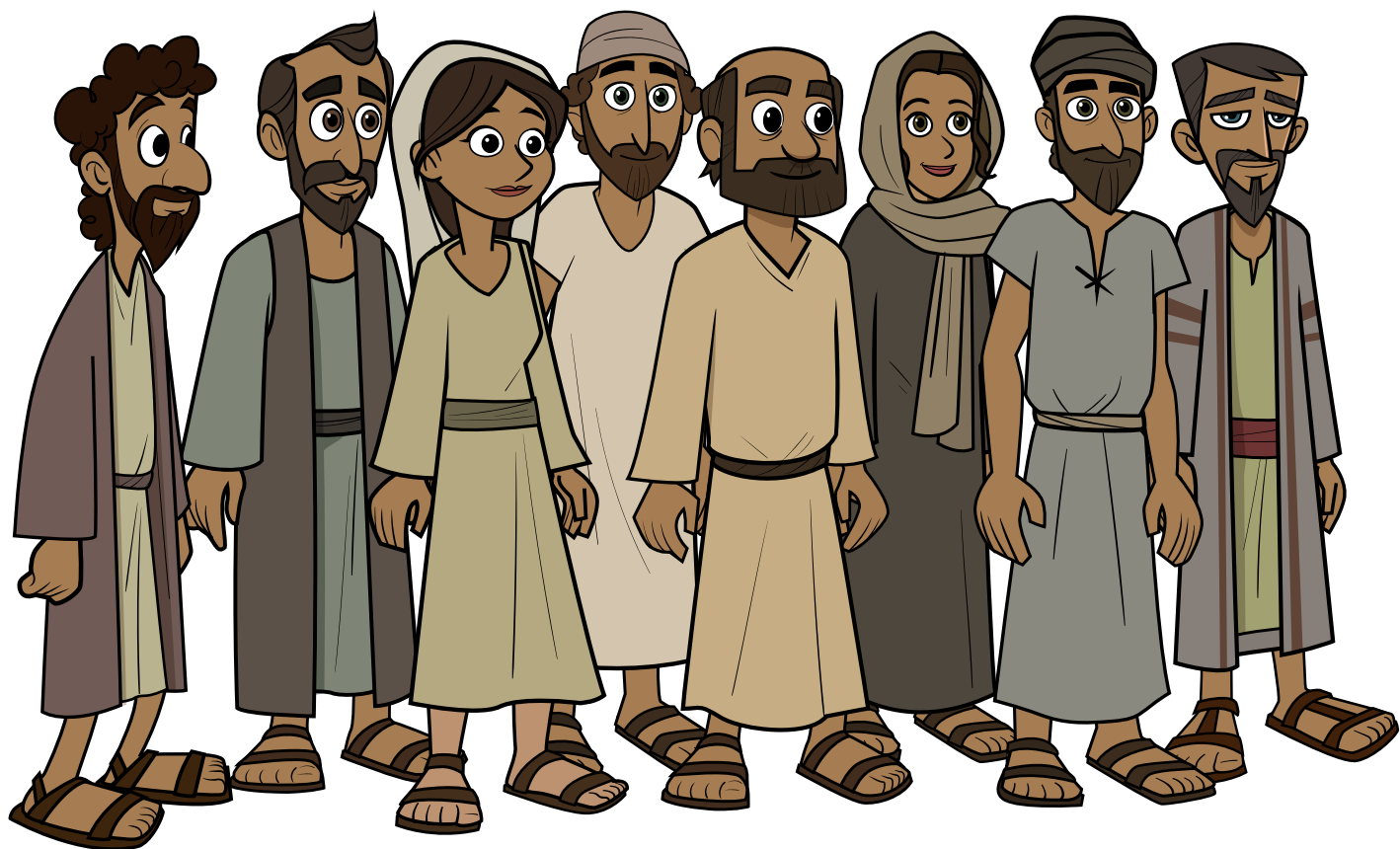
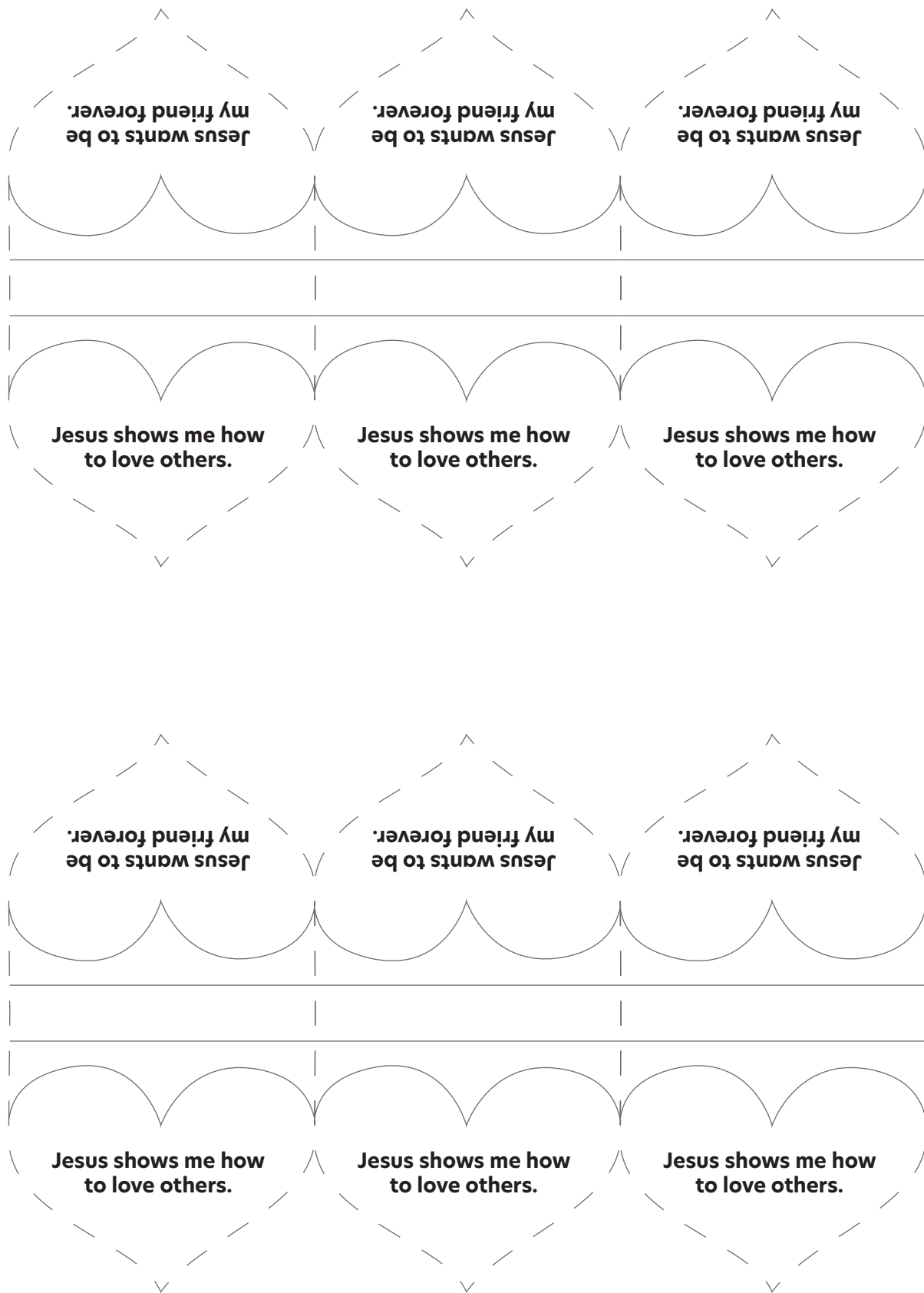


Cornelius' House - Peter and Cornelius • Acts 10; Romans 15:7
